# **M.O.E DONATIONS SCHEME**

TAI has opted into the Ministry of Education donations scheme.

Therefore, as a school, we do not ask for a school donation. Below is some information for whānau around the donations scheme:

- We cannot charge you for anything involved in the core learning programme (curriculum), including "subject fees"
- We can ask you to pay for goods provided that are optional (for example musical instruments and lessons or Sports Academy)
- You need to provide your child with a uniform which you can purchase from The Uniform Shoppe, 521 Rosebank Road, Avondale. Alternatively, you may buy second-hand elsewhere (online).
- If your child is involved in after-school/weekend sports teams, or after-hours
  cultural activities, (extracurricular activities) these are optional. If you choose
  for your child to participate, you may be asked to cover the costs associated
  with these activities.
- We can ask for payment towards overnight camps. You can make a voluntary donation to your school or kura at any time and if you choose to do this, GST is not payable on the donation and you can claim a tax credit.



# **PAYMENT OPTIONS**

KINDO is our preferred payment method for all activities that incur a fee.

Through the app, caregivers can also order school lunches, purchase special items (such as production tickets or leavers' clothing), and request free sanitary products for their child, which will be discreetly delivered to their classroom. # CORE SCHOOL LEARNING TAI WILL PAY FOR

#### **CLASS TRIPS**

Class trips that are directly related to core learning within the curriculum will be funded through the donations scheme.

However, parents will still be required to give permission for their child to attend.

#### **CURRICULUM EVENTS**

Events such as Life Education, which support and promote learning, will also be covered by the donations scheme. Parents will need to provide permission for their child to participate in these events.

#### SPECIALIST/TECHNOLOGY CLASSES

As technology is an integral part of the curriculum, there will be no additional costs for parents for these classes.

#### **INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY**

The Board provides each student with a Chromebook, ensuring that 21st-century learning is accessible to all students. Devices remain at school for educational use.

## **UNIFORM EXPECTATIONS**

At Te Atatū Intermediate, we expect all students to wear their uniform with pride. This means students must wear the correct uniform, in the correct manner, both to and from school.

Uniform items can be purchased from The Uniform Shoppe, located at 521 Rosebank Road, Avondale.

- Our uniform is unisex, with a skirt option available for girls.
- Students should not mix and match their everyday school uniform with PE uniform items. They should either wear the full school uniform or the PE uniform, not a combination of both.
- The full everyday school uniform, including shoes, must be worn to and from school.
- If there is an issue with wearing the correct uniform on any given day, caregivers must email the class teacher explaining the situation. Please ensure the correct uniform is worn again as soon as possible.
- Unfortunately, we are no longer able to host a second-hand uniform sale. Please check online platforms, such as Facebook, for any available second-hand items.
- All uniform items should be clearly named.
- If your child has lost an item, they should first check the Lost & Found before contacting the office. Named items handed to the office will be returned to the student. Unnamed items will be placed in the Lost & Found. If your child is unsure of the location, please ask their class teacher.
