On behalf of the Music Department, we are delighted to welcome you to Te Atatū Intermediate. Our school is proud to offer a wide range of musical opportunities for all students! In addition to classroom Music, Te Atatū Intermediate offers tuition in a wide range of instruments and experiences. Research has shown that playing a musical instrument improves reading and numeracy, as well as communication and social skills. We have seen the positive benefit this has had on TAI students through the years – it is no accident that many of these have gone on to become leaders and top achievers in their next school and beyond. Now it's your turn!

Lessons in the following instruments are FREE: Violin, Trumpet, Trombone, Euphonium, Flute, Clarinet, Saxophone and **Percussion (Not Drumkit)**. These are all group lessons. All students who learn these instruments will be expected to take part in an instrumental performance group. Our performance groups include String Ensemble, Beginner Concert Band, Advanced Concert Band and Rock Band (by audition). Lessons in **Piano, Guitar, Bass Guitar and Drum kit** are offered by **private** tutors. These are paid individual lessons, but group lessons may be arranged by negotiation with the tutor.

In all cases, students will need to supply their **own instruments**. Most instruments can be hired for approximately \$175-400 (the **price depends** on the instrument) for the whole year. The school has a limited number of instruments available where there is financial difficulty.
